## Solicitation No. 1630J6-17-R-00001 Amendment No. 4

Regarding Section G.12 of the Solicitation, is the cost of the contract reduced twice: once by the center operator (contractor) not being able to bill for the vacancy and then again by the subsequent damages being assessed after 30 days?

Section G.12 of the Solicitation refers to "demand for payment for failure to maintain staffing levels." The contractor shall have a maximum vacancy rate not exceeding 4% and a specific number of days to fill certain positions.

Financial damages will not be assessed at the value specified for the vacant position within the first 30 days of the vacancy. However, the center operator may not bill the Government for the vacant position.

Damages will be assessed at the rate of 50 percent of the value specified for the vacant position, from days 21 through 60. Damages will be assessed at the full value specified for the vacant positions after 60 days. Damages will be assessed and subtracted from a subsequent voucher.
