

Conditions of Entry for Hawthorne Army Depot (HWAD)

By signing this document, I declare and acknowledge that my entry onto the Hawthorne Army Depot, a Federal reservation owned by the United States Army under the exclusive jurisdiction of the United States Government, will be permitted under the following conditions:

1. The Hawthorne Army Depot ("HWAD") is a Command designated Restricted Area. All persons, vehicles and property entering the Hawthorne Army Depot are subject to search. I acknowledge that I have no expectation of privacy-either on my person or on any property that I own or possess-when entering HWAD.
2. I will not carry and/or possess any of the following prohibited items on HWAD:
 - Explosives
 - Ammunition
 - Weapons (including handgun, shotguns, rifles, air pistols, air rifles, paintball air guns, bows and crossbows, blank cartridge pistols)
 - Knives (4 inch blade or larger), swords, machetes, straight razors or weapons made from a razor blade
 - All personal protection items such as stun guns, mace, tear gas, OC or Pepper Spray
 - A tanto, kama, tonfu, yawara, or other martial arts weapon or practice device
 - A club, or any object that may be used as a club to inflict bodily harm
 - Fireworks
 - Alcohol
 - Drugs and drug paraphernalia

Note: These prohibitions do not apply to Law Enforcement Officers from any Federal, State or local law enforcement agency who are authorized by their agency to carry firearms in the performance of their duties.

3. Upon entry into this facility, all visitors in possession of a government issued CAC Card or Military ID will be allowed access without further vetting, assuming all credentials are current. Non CAC Card/Military ID card holders will be vetted via our NCIC III vetting process. Un-vetted visitors must submit a Request for Access to Hawthorne Army Depot via completion of SOC Form 271R2, dated May of 2018. It is highly suggested you submit this form to our Security Specialist no later than three weeks in advance to avoid lengthy delay times. Our Security Specialist is James (JD) Justus at james.d.justus.civ@mail.mil and/or 775-945-7012. Once vetted, visitors will be issued visitor badges which they must maintain in his/her possession at all times and displayed in the upper left quarter of their outer garment while on the installation.

4. Visitors are authorized to bring cellular telephones onto the facility that have photographic or digital video recording capability. Visitors are prohibited under **any** circumstances from using the cellular telephone's camera/video recording capability on the installation. Violations of this provision will result in confiscation of the cellular telephone.

With my signature provided below, I understand and acknowledge that should I violate any of the aforementioned prohibitions, I am trespassing on HWAD and I am not authorized to enter or remain on HWAD and that such violation may be criminally prosecuted under Title 18 USC 1382 and/or other Federal Statutes / Regulations and/or Nevada statutes that can be assimilated into Federal Law.
