ECONOMIC PRICE ADJUSTMENT – EXCHANGE RATE FLUCTUATIONS

- 1. Payments under this contract will be in US Dollars. In light of the fluctuation of currency exchange rates, the USG recognizes the need for equity in reimbursement. The GPM will consider cost adjustments (both up and down) based on a survey of the 3 month, moving average exchange rate. A baseline exchange rate of 1194.215 South Korean Won to \$1 US Dollar will be used for purposes of proposal and evaluation, consistent with scheduled final proposal evaluations and revisions for this competitive award as derived from the current 3 month, moving average exchange rate. All surveys and determinations of applicable rates for adjustments under this provision will rely on indexes published in the U.S. Federal Reserve Statistical Release Periodic Updates for Foreign Exchange Rates. (See web link: (http://www.federalreserve.gov/releases/h10/). After award, the rate must sustain an average minimum 8% positive or negative change in the three-month moving average in order to trigger a review. Once a review is requested by the Contractor, it will be at the discretion of the USG to adjust CLIN prices. These price adjustments would not affect already awarded orders. Increases would be limited to no more than 10% of the original awarded contract price (unless prices change due to factors outside of the exchange rate, these changes would be taken into account). There is no limit on the potential adjustment downward. The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer if, at any time during contract performance, fluctuation of the rate of exchange between the U.S. Dollar and the applicable foreign currency has triggered a need for review and adjustment IAW this provision.
- 2. The Contractor shall furnish notice of a need for review within 30 days after the increase or decrease, or within an additive period that the Contracting Officer may approve in writing. The notice shall include the Contractor's cost price proposal for an adjustment to contract unit prices. The proposal shall include cost or pricing data IAW FAR 15.403-4 and supporting rationale.
- 3. Promptly upon receipt of the notice, proposal and data under Para 2 of this clause by the Contracting Officer, the Contracting Officer and the Contractor shall negotiate an adjustment of the contract unit prices. No single contract line item unit price upward

adjustment shall exceed 10% of the baseline price (which for the first adjustment is the original CLIN price as established at contract award). There is no limit on downward adjustments. The Contracting Officer shall then modify the contract:

- To include the negotiated hourly rate adjustments and their effective date, and
- Revise basic contract unit prices, as applicable, due to increases or decreases resulting from negotiation of rate adjustments. The Contractor shall continue performance, as appropriate, consistent with funding and other provisions on existing orders.
- 4. These actions shall be deemed to have established a new baseline both as to price and exchange rate for the purpose of determining subsequent CLIN price adjustments under the same criteria. The new baseline exchange rate shall be the moving average rate applied in the immediately preceding adjustment calculation as per the process in Para 1 and used in the negotiated adjustment.
 - a. Subsequent surveys and requests shall be based on the balance of the process described in Para 1 for the 90 days preceding the subsequent notice required and to be submitted IAW Para 2, except as specified in Para 6 below.
