1.	<u>Identification of the agency and the contracting activity and specific identification of the document as a limited source justification.</u>
	This requirement is in support of GSA, FAS/ITC/Office of Telecommunications Services (OTS), 1800 F Street, NW Washington, D.C. 20405. The contracting activity is Office of Internal Acquisition (OIA), 1800 F Street NW, Washington, DC 20405.
2.	<u>Nature and/or description of the action being approved.</u>
	<p>The Government is seeking to award one Firm-Fixed-Price non-competitive Task Order to Gartner under the IT Research Services Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) award number GS-35F-5014H/GS14H16AAA0008 to acquire research/analysis, validation, and benchmarking services for market pricing relating to telecommunication services and the capability to validate current commercial market pricing.</p> <p>The period of performance for this task order will be one (1), 11-month base period (from date of award until March 31, 2019) and two (2), 1-year option periods.</p>
3.	<u>A complete description of the supplies and/or services required to meet the agency's needs.</u>
	<p>Task 1 is mandatory and Task 2 is optional and also depending on available funding. The vendor shall provide Research-based Advisory Analytical and Benchmarking Services in the following functional areas:</p> <p>4.0.1 Task 1: Wide Area Network (WAN) Telecommunications Commercial Market Research and Analysis</p> <p>4.0.1.1 – WAN Commercial Market Pricing Research and Analysis The government requires market research and analysis of WAN commercial telecommunications market pricing. The Contractor's efforts will be to create WAN commercial telecommunications pricing and market information as it relates to cost elements and pricing found on the GSA OTS contracts. - The contractor will then isolate the local pricing in those respective contracts to match the cities/states that GSA has specified
- The contractor will provide a market price range for telecommunication services.

✓	<p>FAR 8.405-6(a)(1)(i)(B) Only one source is capable of providing the supplies or services required at the level of quality required because the supplies or services are unique or highly specialized</p> <p><i>In accordance with 41 U.S.C. 253(c) and/or 10 U.S.C. 2304(c), GSA has determined that the procurement requires a sole source in order to satisfy the Agency's need. Gartner, Inc is the only practical source for role based services for FAS' telecommunications benchmarking requirement in accordance with FAR 8.405-6(a)(1)(i)(B). Gartner services are at the level of quality that is required because the supplies or services are unique and highly specialized. Gartner's rigorous benchmarking processes and proprietary methodologies consist of access to practices, procedures and rules that distill large volumes of data into clear, precise, actionable insight so that clients can formulate plans and make difficult business decisions. Unique to Gartner, their Benchmarking database is a culmination of research in a specific market, giving GSA a wide-angle view of the relative positions of the market's competitors. Gartner meets the Government's requirement for a service that provides Research-based Advisory Analytical and Benchmarking Services in the area of Wide Area Network (WAN) Telecommunications Commercial Market Research and Analysis on a quality scale that is precise and comparable with historical data.</i></p>

5.	<u>A demonstration by the ordering activity- Contracting Officer- that the order represents the best value consistent with FAR 8.404(d).</u>
	<p>Based on the data gathered, the Contracting Officer has determined that the anticipated price to the Government will be fair and reasonable. The expectation of reaching a fair and reasonable price was determined through market research in order to determine best value for GSA. The IT Research Services BPA was competed and pricing was found to be fair and reasonable. Pricing will be consistent with GSA fixed schedule and BPA pricing, plus any discounts offered.</p> <p>The estimated cost for base mandatory task on this procurement is comparable to a similar procurement that was made in October 2017 in the amount of \$126,704.00 for a 3-month base period with no options (Task Order No. GSH1417AA0208).</p>
6.	<u>A description of the market research conducted among schedule holders, and the results of the research, or a statement why market research was not conducted.</u>
	<p>Market research was conducted in accordance with FAR Part 10. Market research was performed to determine if any practical sources could meet these requirements. A request for information containing the draft statement of work for the requirement was issued to all IT Research BPA holders (Gartner, Inc., Forrester Research, Inc., IDC Research, Inc., Info-Tech Research Group, and The Corporate Executive Board</p>

	<p>Company which was acquired by Gartner Inc.) on April 6, 2018 through April 13, 2018; Gartner was the only BPA holder which responded to the RFI with a capability statement to perform the requirement.</p> <p>A similar RFI was issued to the vendors on the IT Research Services BPA on July 18, 2017 through July 21, 2017 and Gartner Inc. was the only vendor that responded. IDC Government Insights sent an email stating they will not respond because WAN Telecom Commercial Markets is not one that IDC has a deep focus on. Info-Tech also said they will not respond based on the requested deliverables.</p>
7.	<u>Any other facts supporting the limited sources justification.</u>
	None
8.	<u>A statement of the actions, if any, the agency may take to remove or overcome any barriers that led to restricted consideration before any subsequent acquisition for supplies or services is made.</u>
	There will be a need for future benchmarking research. The foundation of the precise and specific analyses that meets GSA stakeholders need has been based and depends on Gartner's methodology and access to its unique database of proprietary, large corporate telecom contract prices. No other vendors have this capability.
