 - **a. Federal Agency and Contracting Activity:** Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation ("PBGC"), Procurement Department ("PD").
 - b. Sponsoring Organization: Office of the Inspector General (OIG)
- **2. Nature and/or description of the action being approved:** This justification ("J&A") for a brand-name procurement utilizing simplified acquisition procedures pursuant to FAR 13.106-1(b) supports the solicitation for brand-name Palo Alto Networks software subscriptions.
- **3.** A description of the supplies or services required to meet the agency's needs (including the estimated value: The Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (PBGC) Office of Inspector General (OIG) maintains its own secure network that includes two (2) PA-3020 firewalls manufactured by Palo Alto. Palo Alto, consequently, is the only original requirement manufacturer (OEM) that provides support and subscription for these firewalls. The subscriptions offered by Palo Alto provide for support and additional security enhancements on a per device basis. OIG requires software subscription for Premium Support, Wildfire, Threat Protection, and URL filtering.

Specifically, Palo Alto Premium Support, through an authorized reseller, provides for normal business hour regular support and 24/7 support in instances in which the firewall is down. Premium support also provides for next-day replacements that are not available at the lower level of support. Threat Protection provides vulnerability and exploit protection, malware protection, and command and control protection. Wildfire provides cloud-based threat analysis. URL filtering subscription allows for filtering based on traffic levels.

The required software subscriptions and estimated quantities are as follows. PBGC anticipates awarding a purchase order for a total performance period of one (1) twelve-month period.

Since the PA-3020 firewalls are Palo Alto proprietary firewalls, only authorized resellers of the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) — Palo Alto — can provide the required subscriptions due to patent rights, copyright, and proprietary processes.

Furthermore, please note that this procurement is only for maintenance and support for existing equipment and licenses and is not a technology refresh or purchase of additional hardware.
