Description

TSTC Background Information

Texas State Technical College ("TSTC") is a state-supported two-year technical college and is the state's largest provider of technical education. In 2015, TSTC was granted single-accreditation status from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges, the regional body for the accreditation of degree-granting higher education institutions in the Southern states. Single-accreditation merged ten (10) college campuses into one state system with administration located in Waco, Texas. This new college has campuses in Abilene, Breckenridge, Brownwood, Fort Bend County, Harlingen, Marshall, North Texas (Red Oak), Sweetwater, Waco, and Williamson County. TSTC educates more than 13,000 students and has 1600 employees across the State of Texas. For more information about TSTC, go to https://tstc.edu/about.

Purpose:

Texas State Technical College (TSTC) is seeking supplier(s) to provide an architectural review of our current BI Architecture, and provide recommendations on the cloud migration of the BI infrastructure. The college would also like to engage augmented support services to stabilize the BI tools (ETL, EDW) and develop multidimensional models to accelerate BI and Analytics self service.

TSTC anticipates the contract to exceed \$100,000 and **will require** that a HUB Subcontracting Plan be submitted. Suppliers are not required to meet the State of Texas HUB goals however, TSTC requires that all suppliers make a good faith effort in achieving those goals. If a **SIGNED** Execution of Offer and HUB Subcontracting Plan is not submitted the bid will be **disqualified**.

This agreement will be for one (1) year with an option to renew for one (1) additional year. Pricing shall be fixed for the initial term of the contract and any annual percentages increase will need approved by TSTC.
